## 2020 GENERAL ELECTION PREPARATION GUIDE FOR VILLAGE OF LOMIRA RESIDENTS



## **ELECTION DAY**

**TUESDAY** 

NOV. 3<sup>RD</sup> 2020

REGISTRATION: the deadline to register online or by mail is Oct. 14<sup>th</sup>. Register online at www.myvote.wi.gov or complete the Voter Registration Form and submit with valid proof of residency. You must have resided at the address you provide on your Registration Form for at least 28 consecutive days prior to Election Day.

The deadline to register in-person prior to Election Day is Friday, October 30<sup>th</sup> by 5pm. Register at the clerk's office located at 425 Water Street, Lomira.

Or, residents may register to vote on Election Day at the polls.

ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL: You may request an absentee ballot by mail via www.myvote.wi.gov or in writing to jrhein@villageoflomira.com or at the clerk's office. Include your name, address, birthdate and photo ID. The last day to request an absentee ballot by mail is Thursday, October 29<sup>th</sup>.

Absentee ballots may be returned via USPS (tracking available at www.myvote.wi.gov) or silver drop box located outside the municipal building at 425 Water Street, Lomira or hand deliver to the clerk's office. Ballots will be accepted until 8pm on Election Day.

IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING: In-person absentee voting will take place at the clerk's office at the Lomira municipal building located at 425 Water Street, Lomira beginning Tuesday, October 20<sup>th</sup> until Friday, October 30<sup>th</sup>. Hours are Monday – Friday 8am to 4pm, except Friday, October 30<sup>th</sup> hours are 8am to 5pm.
